

## Biography of Rajan Khosa

---

Raised in New Delhi and living in London, Rajan Khosa is a writer / director who has worked between the UK, Europe and India for the past decade. His directorial debut "DANCE OF THE WIND", a co-production between six countries, including UK and India, was theatrically released in fifteen countries in 1998-99. It opened at the Venice Film Festival and subsequently won major awards at several festivals including Rotterdam, Chicago, Nantes, as well as the 'Audience Award' at the London Film Festival.

Rajan has directed half a dozen short films. His half hour film "WISDOM TREE" was recipient of the National Award in India and a number of International Awards at film festivals, including Oberhausen, in 1987.

His current film projects as a director are "DREAMS" (a love story set in Mumbai) and "HTO" (a horror-road movie set across the British Midlands and Scotland).

Author of several feature screenplays, Rajan has co-written his most recent script – a martial arts epic, SATORI for Fred Fuchs, producer of Godfather III and Dracula.

Rajan, along with his dear friend, Pan Nalin, founded Monsoon Films in India in 1996 which went on to line-produce 'Dance of the Wind', 'Samsara', and is currently doing 'Valley of Flowers', all produced by Pandora Film, Germany.

His recent participations in multimedia projects have included 'Escapade' which played to a 5000 strong audience at South Bank in London, and ongoing work on Khalsa Heritage Museum in India for his dear friend Amardeep Behl, who is also a production designer of several films.

Rajan trained at the Royal college of Arts in London and at the Film and TV Inst of India, his formative years were spent at the National Institute of Design in Ahmedabad, India.
